

# Terms and Conditions

## The Promoter

1. The Promoter is QIC Robina Pty Ltd (ABN 98 129 955 018) (*the Promoter*) as owners of Robina Town Centre and Robina Super Centre located at Robina Town Centre Drive, Robina in the State of Queensland (*the Centre*).

## The Competition

2. The Promoter as owner of the Centre is offering shoppers who make a purchase from any participating store, located at Robina Super Centre between 8.30am Saturday 27 June 2009 until close of business of all participating stores Saturday 25 July 2009 (*Competition Period*) the chance to win the Prize (*the Competition*).

## The Prize

3. The Prize is an Entertainment package and includes a Samsung 127CM (50") High Definition Plasma TV (PS50B450B1D), Samsung Blu-ray Home Theatre System (HT-BD2ET), KD Concepts 1300mm cabinet from The Good Guys, located at Robina Super Centre (*the Prize*).

## Eligibility

4. To be eligible, entrants who are under 18 years of age must have a parent or guardian complete and sign the entry form on their behalf. If requested, entrants must provide the Promoter with evidence of their age.
5. The following persons are not eligible to enter the Competition:
  - a) owners and managers of the Centre;
  - b) retailers of the Centre;
  - c) suppliers, associated companies and agencies of the Centre; or
  - d) the employees or contractors or immediate family members of the persons and entities in paragraphs (a), (b) and (c).
6. In condition 5, an "immediate family member" of a person means any spouse, child, de facto or any other person who lives at the same premises as that person.
7. The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age and place of residence) and to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry process. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
8. To be eligible to enter the Competition, customers must make any purchase from a participating store at Robina Super Centre during the Competition Period (*an Eligible Transaction*).
9. Payment for services (e.g. electricity, gas, telephone), registrations (e.g. motor vehicle registration), premiums (e.g. insurance and health fund premiums), rates, subscriptions (e.g. ambulance subscriptions), deposits or payments to financial institutions and any similar payments will not qualify as an Eligible Transaction.

## Entry Forms

10. To enter the Competition, the customer must collect an entry form supplied from the participating store at the time of completing the Eligible Transaction.
11. One entry form only will be provided for each Eligible Transaction.
12. Customers can make more than one Eligible Transaction.
13. All entry details must be fully completed on the entry form. The entry form must be placed in any of the entry boxes located in any participating store during the Competition Period. Any entries received after close of business of all participating stores Saturday 25 July 2009 will not be included in the Competition.
14. To be valid, each entry form must be an original entry form obtained from:
  - a) a participating store;
  - b) the Gold Coast Sun Newspaper; or
  - c) collected in a brochure form from a letter box,and provided or endorsed by the Promoter and must be signed by the eligible entrant or by the entrant's parent or guardian if the entrant is under 18 years of age.

## Prize

15. There will be one (1) Prize and one (1) winner of the Prize.
16. The Prize is neither transferable nor exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash, either in whole or in part.

## Drawing of the Prize

17. The Prize winner will be drawn by close of business of all participating stores Monday 27 July 2009 at Robina Town Centre, Centre Management Office.
18. The Prize winner for the draw will be the first entry form drawn from the entry box that is correctly completed in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. If the Prize winner is under 18 years of age, then the parent or guardian of the Prize winner who signed the entry form will be deemed to be the Prize winner for the purposes of the Competition.
19. The Prize winner does not have to be present at the time or place of the draw.
20. The Promoter will use reasonable endeavours to notify by mail, telephone or otherwise of the Prize winner to arrange collection of the Prize and once notified, the Prize winner must collect their Prize within three months of the draw.
21. If the Promoter is unable to locate or contact the Prize winner within three months after the draw then another Prize winner will be drawn.
22. The Promoter is not obliged to publish the results of the Competition.
23. A person claiming to be a Prize winner will be required to provide proof of identity.
24. The Promoter's decision on eligibility for the Prize is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into in relation to the conduct of the Competition or otherwise.

## Other General Terms

25. All entry forms remain the property of the Promoter.
26. The Prize winner agrees to provide information and photographs of themselves for marketing and publicity use if requested by the Promoter.
27. The Promoter accepts no liability whatsoever for any loss, damage or injury whatsoever that may arise in any way from the use of the Prize or the conduct of the Competition. The Prize winner must, on demand, indemnify and keep indemnified, the Promoter, its subsidiaries, employees, advisers and agents against all claims, losses, damages, costs and expenses reasonably or lawfully suffered or incurred by the Promoter by reason of any loss, damage or injury incurred by the Promoter arising out of this Competition.
28. If this Competition is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law to:
  - a) disqualify any entrant; and/or
  - b) subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority, to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the Competition, as appropriate.
29. Under the Privacy Act, the Promoter must tell you when it collects personal information about you and how it will use it. If you choose to enter or take part in the Competition, you will be required to provide information about yourself. The Promoter will collect and use the personal information you have provided for the purpose of carrying out this Competition and may use it for marketing promotions. The Promoter may use your information to send you publications or other promotional material. The Promoter may supply the personal information to contractors which assist the Promoter to do this, to organisations which provide special prizes or offers and which are clearly associated with the Competition and to selected approved organisations which may use it to inform you about other products, services or events. By entering the Competition, you consent to the collection and use of your information in this way.
